

End of Course Exams

High School End of Course Exams will be given the last week of April. During those 7 days, we will run a two-hour delayed start schedule. Please make sure your student comes to testing with a fully charged Chromebook. Students who are testing will report to their testing locations no later than 7:35 am. Specific testing dates are as follows:

English: April 23rd and 24th

All 9th and 10th grade students will report to testing for the English End of Course Exams.

Algebra and Geometry: April 25th and 26th

Students enrolled in the following courses will report to testing for Algebra and Geometry: Algebra I, Geometry, Honors Geometry

US History: April 27th

Students enrolled in the following courses will report to testing for US History: US History (Note: APUSH students will NOT report to testing)

Government: April 30th and May 1st

Students enrolled in the following courses will report to testing for Government: American Government (Note: AP Government students will NOT report to testing)

Biology: April 30th and May 1st

Students enrolled in the following courses will report to testing for Biology: Biology

AP Review Sessions

Students taking AP classes will participate in AP review sessions during the two-hour delayed start (7:40 - 9:40). A sign up was sent to students on Thursday. AP students are required to attend AP review session and must complete all sign ups by Thursday, April 19th.

School Walkout

On Friday, April 20th at 10 am, the student body of both the Chagrin Falls Middle and High school will join together to commemorate the 17 victims of the Parkland shooting and the nearly 300 (296) people killed in school shootings since Columbine in 1999. This event was planned and organized by CFHS and CFMS students. Students will meet on the turf for 17 minutes of silence, and then return back to classes until all of the lunch periods have ended. During 7th and 8th period, students who would like to take action will meet in the PAC. For these two periods, students will write letters to representatives, register those who are eligible to vote and work with the Coach Hall Foundation which was established after the shooting at Chardon High School in 2012.

We are working with the CFPD and will have extra officers on campus to ensure the safety of our study body. Classes will continue as regularly scheduled and students who choose not to participate in these activities will follow their typical schedule.
