

Graduation Events for the Class of 2019

Friday, May 31

10 a.m. Mandatory graduation rehearsal in the PAC. Tickets and caps/gowns will be distributed at the end of rehearsal. Please iron the gowns.

Noon Rehearsal for graduation speakers in the PAC.

1 p.m. Rehearsal for senior performers in the Baccalaureate program at the Federated Church.

6 p.m. Senior Banquet in the high school commons. This is a voluntary gathering of the class, faculty, and administration for a dinner and program.

Saturday, June 1

6 p.m. Baccalaureate at the Federated Church (No tickets required): This is a voluntary gathering of the class, parents, relatives, friends, and representatives of the faculty, administration, and Board of Education for a spiritual, philosophical perspective on graduation. Seniors will be in their caps and gowns. Seniors need to arrive at 5:15.

Sunday, June 2

2 p.m. Graduation (11 a.m. outdoor contingency plan). Seniors need to arrive at 1:15 p.m. for a 2 p.m. ceremony or 10:15 a.m. for an 11:00 a.m. ceremony. They should report to the high school gymnasium. A decision about the time will be made early that morning according to the weather forecast. The school community will receive notification of the official time prior to the ceremony on June 2.

Stadium Seating (No tickets required): The stadium will be closed and cleaned for graduation during the week prior to graduation. Any blankets, quilts, reserved signs, etc. placed in the stadium prior to then will be removed during the cleaning. The stadium will open at noon on Sunday for the 2:00 p.m. commencement or at 9 a.m. in the case of a morning commencement.

Indoor Seating (Tickets required): Every effort will be made to hold graduation outdoors in Harris Stadium. If graduation is indoors due to the weather, tickets are necessary. On the day of graduation rehearsal, each senior will receive **SIX TICKETS** (4 for the PAC and 2 for Middle School Gym). There are no extras.

Handicapped Parking. For either an outdoor or an indoor ceremony, handicapped parking and seating will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Males: Wear dress pants of the color of your choosing, a dress shirt, and a tie.
