

## If you are not at school, here is what you can do!

1. Poetry: The students will circle snap words in their poetry notebooks, illustrate their pictures and read their poems at least 3x each while pointing to the words.
2. Reading: The students will read book box books that have been previously sent home at least 3x each, circling any snap words that they find. Students may also choose to color any pictures in their books that have not been colored.
3. Math: Students will practice counting by 1's to 100. Students will practice counting backwards from 10. Students can look around their house, count and write down one of the following choices each day: shoes, forks, cups, pillows, light bulbs, windows, doors, clocks, light switches, and plates etc.
4. Science: Students will observe the weather each day and draw a picture illustrating what they observed. For example: sunny, rainy, cloudy, snowy...etc.
5. Writing/Social Studies: Students need to illustrate a picture of themselves showing "pride" at home. (Something that they did that goes along with Tiger Pride: polite, responsible, in control, don't quit, encourage others.) They need to stretch out their words and below their picture they will write about it, describing how they showed pride that day.
