Program: ***Baldwin Wallace University Summer Music Institute for High School Students, Middle School Students, and Upper Elementary Students***

Program Description: The Baldwin-Wallace College Summer Music Program is designed to provide students with the opportunity to enhance their music skills. A variety of sessions are offered through the summer program. String camp, band camp, and music theatre camp are offered for students in grades 4-9; applications are due May 1, 2020. The Conservatory Summer Institute, which runs July 2-11, 2020, is geared toward high school students who are interested in studying music in college.
